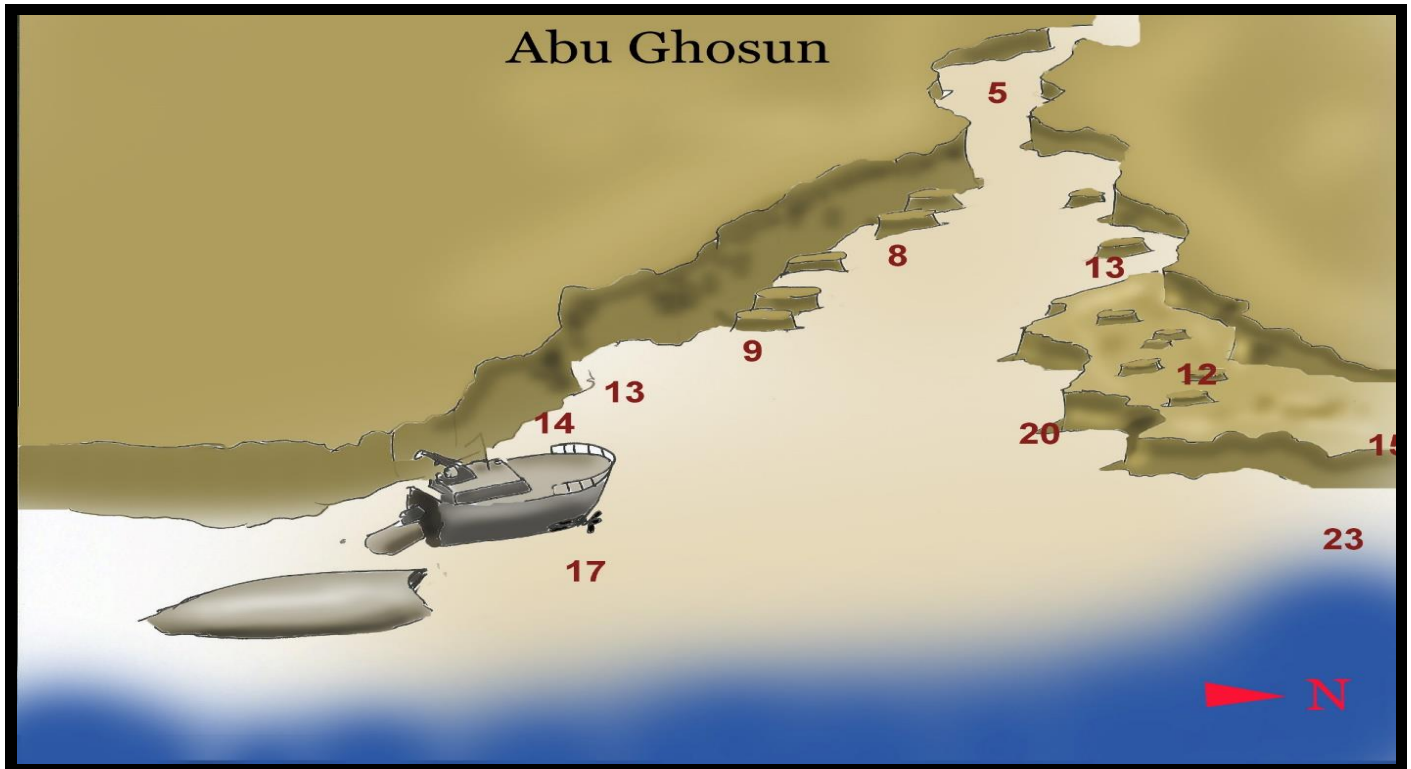


Abu Ghosun Wreck

(Bus trip



Distance: 2 hours by minibus in south direction.

Description: The wreck in Abu Ghosun is one of the only wrecks you can dive via shore in Egypt. There are not many wrecks in Marsa Alam. The “Hamada” is easy to dive and located on the south side of the reef in Abu Ghosun. The wreck is only in 18 meter depth. It was loaded with tons of small plastic Silicate. The poor navigation and crew mistake is the reason why it came to this average. It crashed into the reef and broke into two parts. Now it is the home for thousands of glassfish’s and some turtles have named it now their home. We have some swim through and some areas, which make the wreck quite interesting for, wreck dive beginners.

Flora and Fauna: Turtles, glassfish, grouper, parrot fish, squid, anemones and beautiful soft corals covering the wreck.

Difficulty: Easy dive, less current. Suitable for all diver levels and snorkelers.

Depth: 6 – 18 Meter
